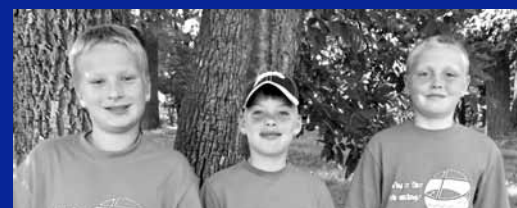


COUNSELOR IN TRAINING

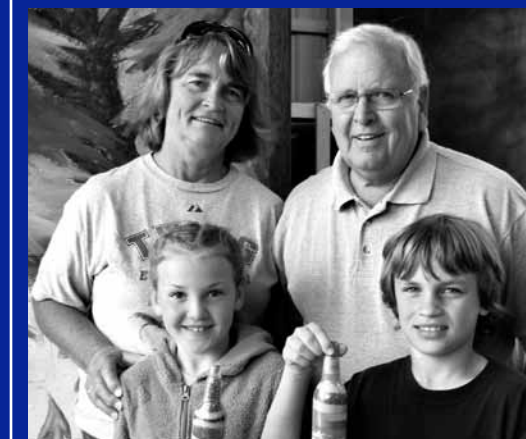

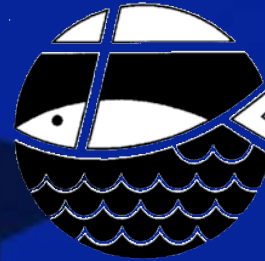

Camp Metigoshe is located north of Bottineau, ND on Pelican Lake. Camp Metigoshe is an ELCA Bible camp that welcomes ALL campers.

2012 Camp Fees:

Camp Metigoshe is now an all-inclusive camp! Included in your 2012 camp fees are food & drink trading post costs for your afternoon and evening snacks. Plus, there are no increases in any camp fees for the 2012 season!

After You Register: After we receive your registration, a link to the Camp Packet will be emailed to the address provided. If an email address is not available, we will send the Camp Packet via postal mail. This packet will include a receipt, a health history form and some informational material. If the camp program you register for will include a high ropes experience, a release form will also be included in the packet.

Note: If you do not receive a link to the Camp Packet or receive a packet in the mail, you are not registered. Please call the camp office if you do not receive your information.

Balance Due: All balances will be due **two weeks prior** to the beginning of your camp session.

Late Fees: Balances not paid two weeks prior to your camp date will have an additional \$20.00 late charge applied to the balance.

Late Registration: If you register within one month of your camp session, your entire balance will be due with your registration form.

Family & Grandparents Camp: To register for Family and/or Grandparents Camp complete the enclosed Family/Grandparents Camp registration form located on the back of the summer camp registration form or go to www.MetigosheMinistries.com and print a registration form found in the "Forms" section.

Early Bird Incentive: If your registration and \$100 deposit is postmarked on or before Friday, April 6, we will deduct \$10 from the final balance OR send you a FREE Camp Metigoshe t-shirt!

Refund Policy: Your \$100 deposit is refundable on or before May 31 or up to 30 days before the registered camp session. Any cancellation after May 31 or within 30 days of the registered camp session, \$100 deposit is non-refundable.

Live Simply: Do you know we try to "live simply" at Camp Metigoshe? Our cabins are lit by the soft glow of lanterns. Outdoor troughs with running water replace sinks, vaulted outhouses replace flushable toilets, and saunas and swimming replace showers.
